YESCARTA® or TECARTUS® may cause side effects that are life-threatening and can lead to death.

Call or see your oncologist or get emergency help **RIGHT AWAY** if you have any of **these symptoms**:

- Fever (100.4°F/38°C or higher)
- Difficulty breathing
- Chills or shaking chills
- Confusion
- Dizziness or lightheadedness
- Severe nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Fast or irregular heartbeat
- Severe fatigue or weakness

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
